Steeler tickets are due November 10. All proceeds from this raffle go to the General Fund from which all members benefit. Expenses per student this year will be over \$1000 per student, and the balance over the assessment of \$495 will come from the general fund. Winner will be based on the 3 digit lottery number on Thanksgiving Day. Every student who sells all his/her tickets will be entered in a drawing to win \$50 for the student and \$50 for that student's parents. The winner will be drawn at the band banquet.
