General Membership Meeting Minutes from May 20, 2009 were approved and filed.

Financial Analyst – Barb Hilty

General Fund money raised for the year was \$48,342 which leaves us \$23,632 short of our goal of \$71,974. This short fall will decrease slightly after the money raised from the golf outing is added to the total. The money from the golf outing will go towards the General Fund for the 2008-2009 season.

For the 2009-2010 season our General Fund goal will be \$57,540. The cost per student is \$706.85 and the student assessment is \$295.

Kevin requested that everyone include their address when requesting reimbursement to speed up the process of getting you your money.

Financial Secretary – Sandy Bauer

Sandy is working on account statements to finish out the 2008-2009 season and to begin the 2009-2010 season. This year's statements will look different from last year. The statements will show the deduction of the student assessment of \$295 from the beginning of the season. Do not panic the assessment is not due until Jan. 31, 2010. By showing the deduction at the beginning of the season you will see how you are doing towards making your goal as the fundraising credits are added to your account.
