- General Fund Goal is \$57,540. Year to date General Fund income is \$17,212.
- Student income assessment goal is \$35,848.75. Year to date paid is \$20,507.93.

Sandy Bauer – Financial Secretary

- Student Assessment statements were mailed on November 14. If you haven't received your current statement, please notify Sandy. 54 students are currently paid in full.
- Due to the many fundraisers recently, student credit reports are still coming in for Corbis, Kids Stuff and Sarris candy and are not included on the current report.
- Instrument purchase guidelines – Because instruments are a large purchase, you are only able to submit purchase request one time. You may use your account to pay for used instruments also.

Colleen Blackham – Ways and Means

- Total Fundraised for General Fund in October is \$12,119.79. This number includes the Kiski Competition, but not the Car Cruise. The Kiski Competition raised about \$1000 more this year than last year. Car Cruise profit was \$7716. We will donate \$200 each to the same three local food banks we donated to last year.
- Not as much fall fruit orders as last year, but decided to proceed with the fundraiser.
- Steeler's raffle did not do as well as last year. Last year profit was \$6900, this year we only have \$4400 thus far. Please return any sold or unsold ticket as soon as possible.
- 4 Pens tickets were donated to us by Emanuelsons. We will distribute raffle tickets to students in January to be sold for \$5.00 each. Game is in March.

- Distributed copies of the Winterguard budget for the year. Assessments for high school is \$395 and \$254 for intermediate school. Will attend a regional in Dayton,

February 26-28th. Need to raise \$8880 for General Fund. We should be able to raise the money with fundraisers and the Championships on March 27th at Kiski. Please mark this date on your calendars. If you can volunteer even a couple of hours, it is appreciated. Diane Arner made a motion to approve budget, all agreed.
